

Brief Profile of Eminent Guests



Rajit Kapoor is a commerce graduate who was caught spouting Shakespearean Sonnets in Yugantar by Shyam Benegal, Director. He was offered the role of Manek Mullah in Benegal's Suraj Ka Satvan Ghoda (1993).

In Basu Chatterjee's Byomekesh Bakshi (1993), he played role of a detective. The actor who chooses substance over glamour was part of Benegal's trilogy – as Riyaz in Mammo (1994) and Zubeidaa (2001) and as Sadiq in Sardari Begum (1996).

He was again 'the chosen one' when Benegal decided to make the movie The Making of Mahatma (1996). He played the role of Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, who during his days as a barrister, travels to Britain to handle a case and is at the receiving end of racial discrimination. His performance won him the National Film Award for Best Actor.

In 2009, he was seen in Yeh Mera India (2009) and played the role of Anupam Kher's son in Morning Walk (2009). The actor gets a chance to investigate a murder in Rajesh Ganguly's murder mystery Blue Oranges (2009).



Anna Niderhaus is a Coordinator and Manager of 'The School Film Library Project' 70 in Polish Film Institute. School Film Library represents an educational programme the objective of which is to provide pupils with the basic knowledge on the film and its perception. This innovative programme was inaugurated in 2009 and 15000 schools have been already acknowledged and awarded with two important prizes founded by: Polish Ministry of Education (Educational Initiative of the Year) and 27th International Young Audience Film Festival Ale Kino! in Poznań (Platinum Goats for the outstanding young audience film and media literacy event).



Shri Shiv Kumar Born on 16th December, 1949. Shri Shiv Kumar is a native of Mumbai. He obtained his Degree in Science and Diploma in Cinema in Direction from FTII, Pune. She has served in the International Jury for the SAFMA Documentary Festival in Kathmandu, 2008. She has served in the Jury for the National Awards (Feature Films) in 2001 and 2008. She has won the National Award for Writings on Cinema given by the President of India, in 2001. She also won the Bharat Nirman Award for Excellence in Journalism, 2008.
